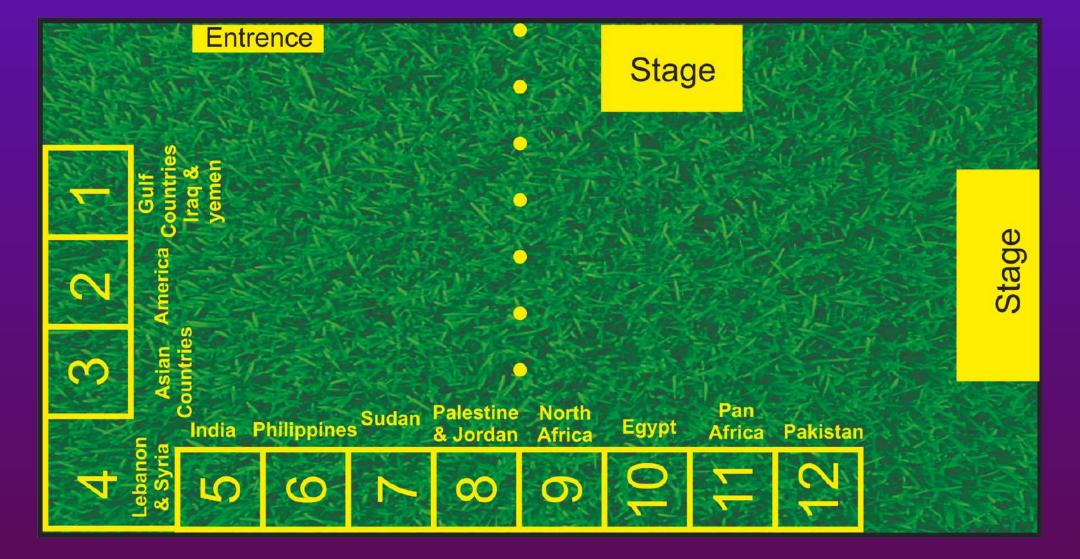
IMPORTANT INFORMATION:
